Lisa Fisher and Nancy Draayer spent a couple weeks in Turkey in October. Their airline vouchers were going to expire so they had to use them. Nancy wrote this note to us:

Some of you may have apprehensions about traveling internationally during the pandemic. I had those apprehensions as well, but with routine precautions and allowances for testing, it was an enjoyable experience. Yes, you may have to show proof of vaccination, take a Covid test, and wear your mask in airports and on long flights, but for me it was worth it to be able to travel again.

Using an unused airline ticket from a previously cancelled trip, I was off on an adventure with Lisa Fisher. We arrived in Istanbul after about a 10 hour flight. Istanbul is a lovely city with history dating back hundreds of years. Some of you may be going to Turkey with FF soon, so I recommend the usual sights: the spice market, Blue mosque, Hagia Sophia, etc. I also found it interesting to visit the Topkapi Palace, headquarters of the Ottoman sultans dating back as far as the 15th century compared with the ostentatious Dolmabahce Palace used by the Ottoman sultans from 1856 to 1922. One of my favorite experiences was going to the Seven Hills Restaurant terrace overlooking the Hagia Sofia after sundown during the call to prayer with the Blue Mosque in the background.
